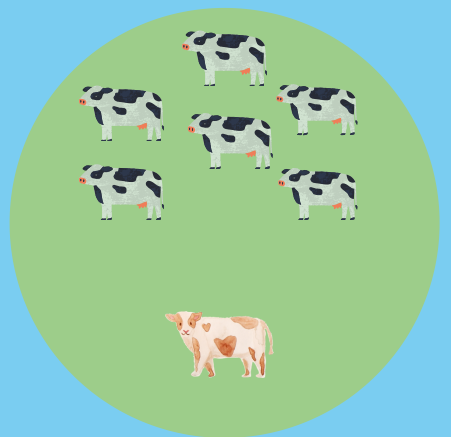


THE NORTH IS IN FASHION
